


Report of the Online Programme "Baishe Shrabaon"












Students attendance on Independence Day, 2021






Report on Sadbhavana Dibas Celebration

An Interactive Session with students provided a platform for lively discussions, exchange of ideas, and reflections on the themes presented during the event, fostering intellectual engagement and inquiry.




Report on World Book Day


