The event commemorating International Democracy Day took place on September 15, 2022, at the College Auditorium of Government General Degree College, Kalna-I.



The session culminated in a collective rendition of the national anthem, symbolizing unity and allegiance to our nation's foundational principles.


























Report on University Sports [Athletic] 2022-23







Report of Human Rights Day celebration





The seminar served as a platform to celebrate the significance of mathematics and its applications, honouring the legacy of renowned mathematicians while fostering academic discourse and learning.





Report on Netaji Jayanti Celebration at Government General Degree College Kalna-I


