GOVERNMENT GENERAL DEGREE COLLEGE, KALNA-I, The First Party represented herein by its Principal as Representative and Competent Authority (Hereinafter referred as "First Party", the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors — in office, administrators and assigns)

KANKURIA GRAM PANCHYAT, KALNA I BLOCK, PURBA BARDHAMAN The Second party and represented herein by its Pradhan as Representative and Competent Authority (Hereinafter represented as "Second Party", the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors—in office, administrators and assigns)

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS

- A) FIRST PARTY is a Government Higher Educational Institution named:
- i) Government General Degree College, Kalna-I, Purba Bardhaman-713405
- B) First Party and Second Party believe that collaboration and cooperation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts in cooperation within the area of infrastructural development, sharing of social responsibilities, community awareness generation with best effort, mutual benefit, and frequent interactions.
- D) Both Parties being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E) Kankuria Gram Panchayat, Kalna I Block, Purba Bardhaman Pin 713405, the Second Party is a rural local body in Kalna I Panchayat Samiti part of Purba Bardhaman Zila Parishad consisting of 10 villages under the aegis of Department of Panchayats and Rural Development Government of West Bengal and is engaged in maintaining developmental responsibilities through community participation via elected representatives' and extension thereafter.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISE SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

#### Clause-I PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- 1.1 Collection and management of solid waste, liquid waste and unhazardous chemical waste generated from the College and or its students' laboratories through the logistics governed by the Gram Panchayat
- 1.2 Organization of social awareness programme and help the NSS unit of the College to conduct outreach programme in the neighbouring villages.
- 1.3 Involving students in community based and promotional activities and
- 1.4 Exchange of information on rural development, environmental monitoring, population and other matters relevant to their educational and research programme
- 1.5 Any other joint venture for academic and community enrichment of the area on prior agreement of the concerned authorities of both the organization.

- 1.6 Both the organizations Government General Degree College, Kalna I and Kankuria Gram Panchayat will abide the rules and regulations related to waste management set forth by the State Government and Central Government.
- 1.7 Both the Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.8 Both the Parties mutually agreed not to include any financial transaction during the execution of this MOU.
- 1.9 Neither Party shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligation under this MOU due to circumstances beyond their control but not limited to pandemic, war, flood etc. If such condition continues beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.
- 1.10 Nothing in this MOU shall be constructed to make either party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.
- 1.11 This MOU unless terminated by mutual written agreement will continue for 5 years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph and can be renewed through mutual interest. Either Party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 90 days prior written notice to the other party.



## Day Three: 30 August 2022 Tree plantation programme and Swachata Avijan

NSS special camp was organised in the adopted village named Uttarpara, Muragacha, Purba Bardhaman-713405. This village is a remote village far away from the megacity. So, urban problems like wastage from heavy industries, air pollution not find here. But Plastic and polythins occurred pollutions here.

Literal meaning of Swachhta is 'স্বচ্ছুতা বা পরিচ্ছন্নতার মনোভাব ও পরিকল্পনা, পরিচ্ছন্নতার অভ্যাস'. (Habbit of cleanliness , desire for cleanliness , planning of cleanliness ). So, Our NSS Unit concentrated its focus on keywords like Cleanliness, Serenity, Sincerity and Transparency. Our Principal gave the volunteers a different perspective on Swachhta and told that Swachhta is not only related to the environment but also our health and daily life. Our volunteers observed that the villagers have lack of awareness about cleanliness . Our NSS volunteers plan to clean garbage's and plant trees for fresh air. For purpose NSS volunteers clean garbage's and swept the local roads and surroundings, collected plastics pouch, carry bags, etc.





The students encouraged the villagers by telling that the clean house will be rewarded at the end of the camp and also insisted to keep clean daily. So they happily involved themselves in cleaning process. The NSS volunteers also educated them that cleanliness and Hygiene is necessary to keep them disease free. The local People were happy on seeing the involvement of the students, and promised them that they will use dust bin and clean their premises regularly.

#### Tree Plantation Programme

Our next programme was tree plantation. Our NSS volunteers planted trees in this local area. More than fifty trees were planted in adapted village. They fenced the saplings in proper way to protect the plants from domestic animals. Our volunteers campaigned for saving trees.
