1.1 Both the Parties are united by common interest and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance -




- Joint research projects and publications, including work by undergraduate and post graduate students at the partner institutions;

within the Institution and its related wings.


1.2 Both the Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that
